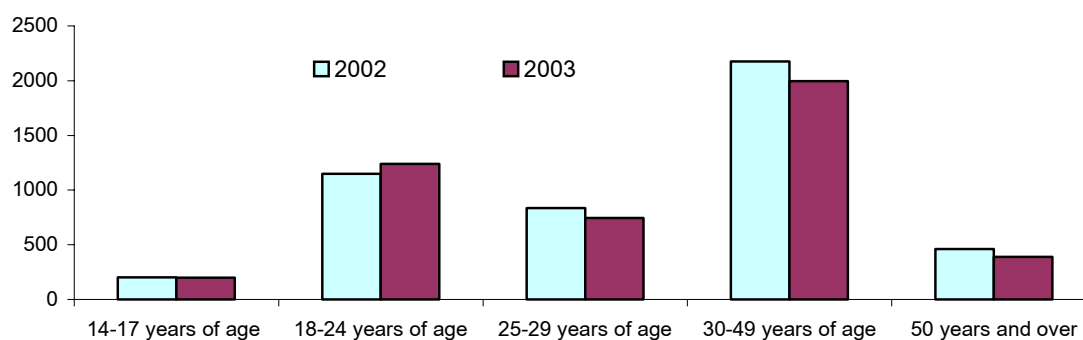


## 11. Number and Composition of Persons brought to Judicial Responsibility and Applying of Criminal Penalties

In 2003 number of convicted persons in the republic decreased by 5.3% compared to 2002 and comprised 4567 persons. 262 or 5.7 % among them were females, 198 or 4.3% - were juveniles. Proceedings on 364 persons were discontinued, 7 persons were acquitted.

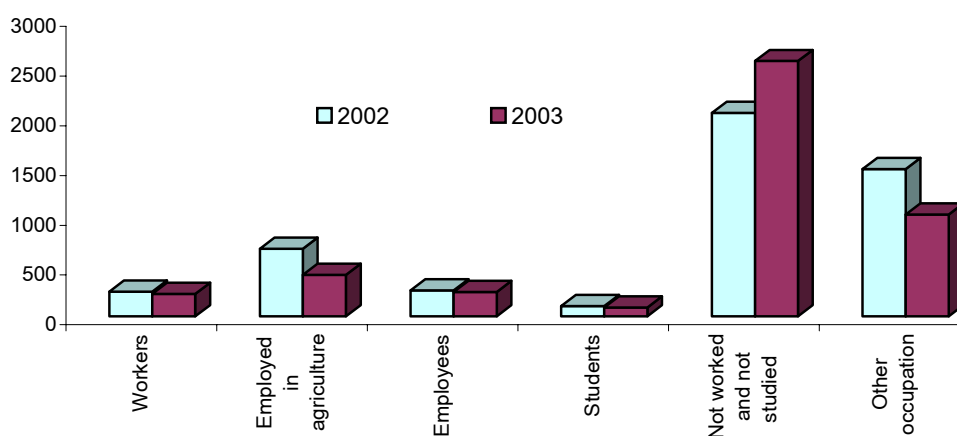
**11.1. Age composition of convicted persons.** Persons aged 30-49 in the total number of convicted persons comprised 43.7%, which decreased by 8.3% compared to 2002. Similar tendency was also recorded among 14-17, 25-29 and 50 and over age groups, by 1.5, 10.8 and 15.6% respectively.

**11.2. Distribution of convicted persons by employment before imprisonment.** 56.3% of convicted persons were at the working age, but didn't work or study before being convicting; their number compared to 2002 increased by 25.4%, and number of employed in agriculture, students, workers and employees decreased by 38.9, 14.6, 8.9 and 5.8%

**11.3. Number of convicted persons by types of crime and sex.** Persons convicted of a property plunder comprise considerably big share in the total number of convicted persons - 25.4%, number of which increased by 6.1% compared to 2002. Number of convicted persons rather increased by the types of crimes compared to 2002. Thus, number of the persons convicted of a hooliganism, intentional homicide, and malicious grievous bodily injury significantly increased by 27.5, 15.9 and 11.4%, respectively, while number of the persons convicted of drug-related crimes decreased by 9.4%.

Number of females convicted of a hooliganism increased by 33.3%, while number of females convicted of drug-related crimes and malicious grievous bodily injury decreased by 92.3 and 57.1%, respectively.

15.8% of the persons convicted were in a state of drunkenness while committing a crime, and 32.3% committed a crime by group.

**11.4. Number of convicted juveniles by types of crimes and sex.** Number of convicted juveniles decreased by 1.5% compared to 2002, and number of girls - 25.0%.

Persons convicted of a property plunder by theft comprised a big share in the total number of convicted juveniles - 53.5%, number of which compared to 2002 increased by 12.8%.

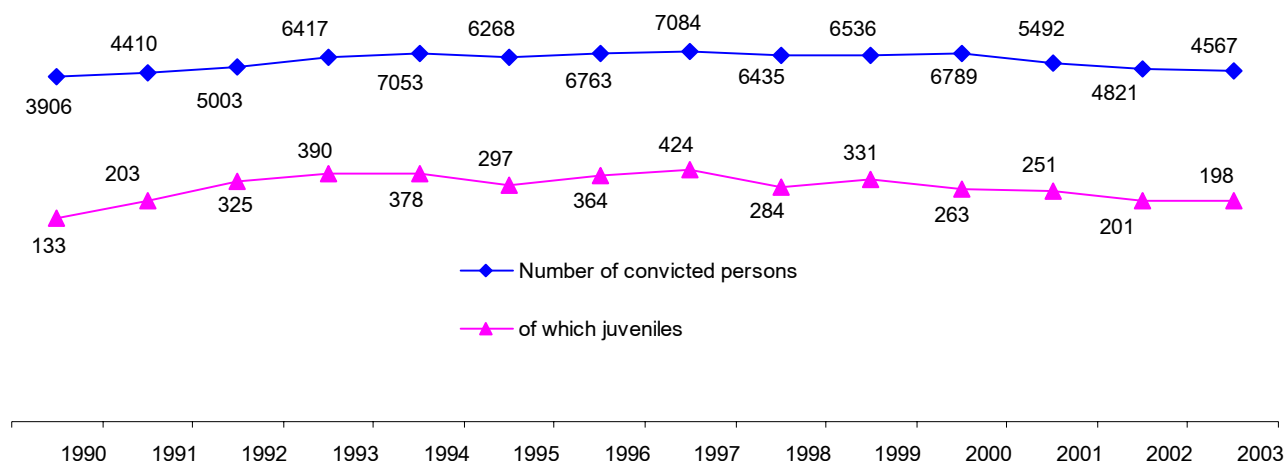
86 out of convicted juveniles were not working and not studying, 7 committed a crime in a state of drunkenness, 119 – by a group, 27 – with participation of adults.

11.5. *Distribution of convicted persons by types of crimes.* Distribution of the persons convicted by the sentences came into legal force by types of crimes for 2003 has the following picture:

88 convicted persons were delivered up for re-education and supervision. 39 convicted persons were imposed extra penalties, property of 11 of them was confiscated, 28 were deprived of holding certain posts or the right to deal with certain activity.

37.7% of convicted persons were imprisoned in 2003, and the other 62.3% were imposed other penalties. The 33.2% of the persons convicted an imprisonment were imprisoned up to 1 year, and the 1.2% - maximum from 10-15 years. While, by the penalties' increase the number of imprisoned persons has a tendency of decrease. The maximum share of imprisoned persons was the persons convicted of a property plunder (35.0%).

42 convicted juveniles or 21.2% were imprisoned for the duration from 1 to 10 years, and the other 78.8% were imposed different penalties – correctional labour, conditioned arrest, etc.
