

2. Specialized secondary education

2.1. Activity of specialized secondary state education establishments. 81 specialized secondary state education establishments functioned in the Republic of Armenia for 2003/2004 academic year (77 and 5 branches for 2002/2003 academic year). Number of students comprised 28636 persons, of which 69.1% females. Education has been implemented based on the basic general and secondary (complete) general education.

80.1% of students studied in the paid education system and 19.9% - by state order.

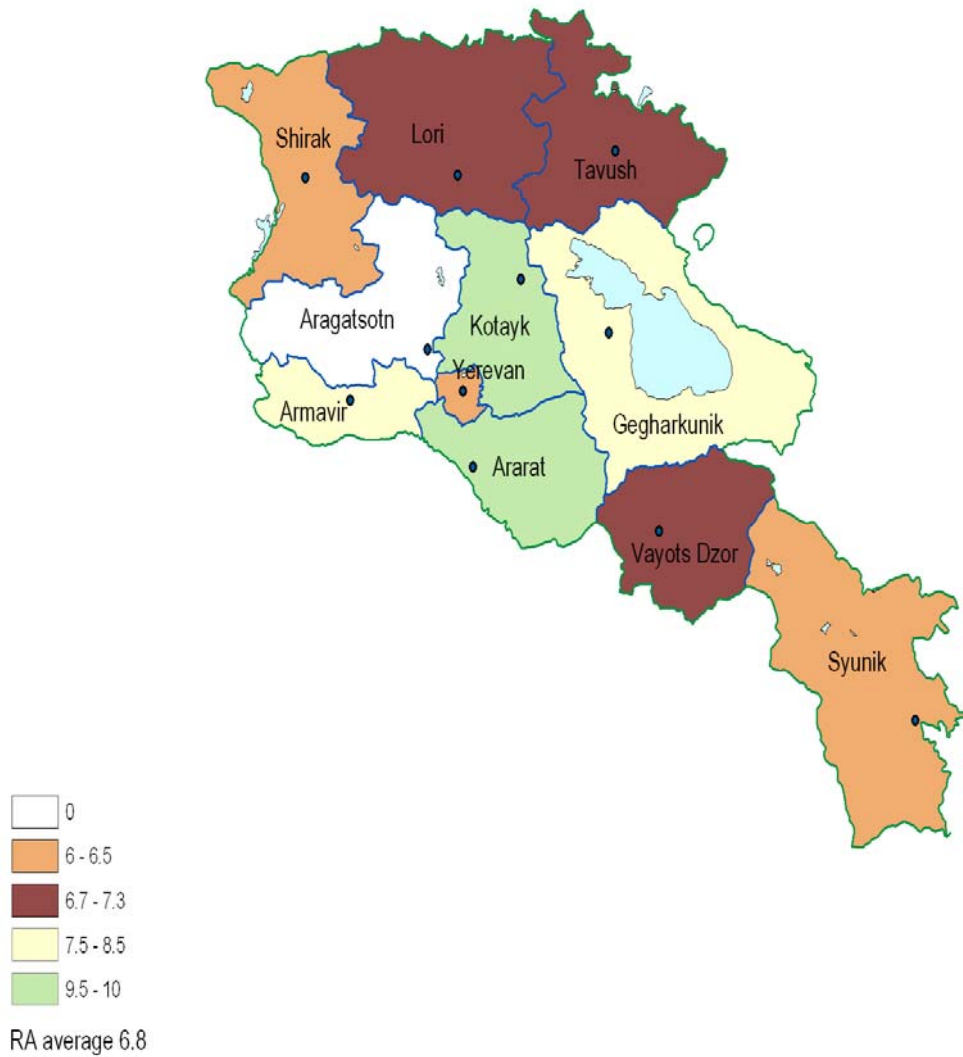

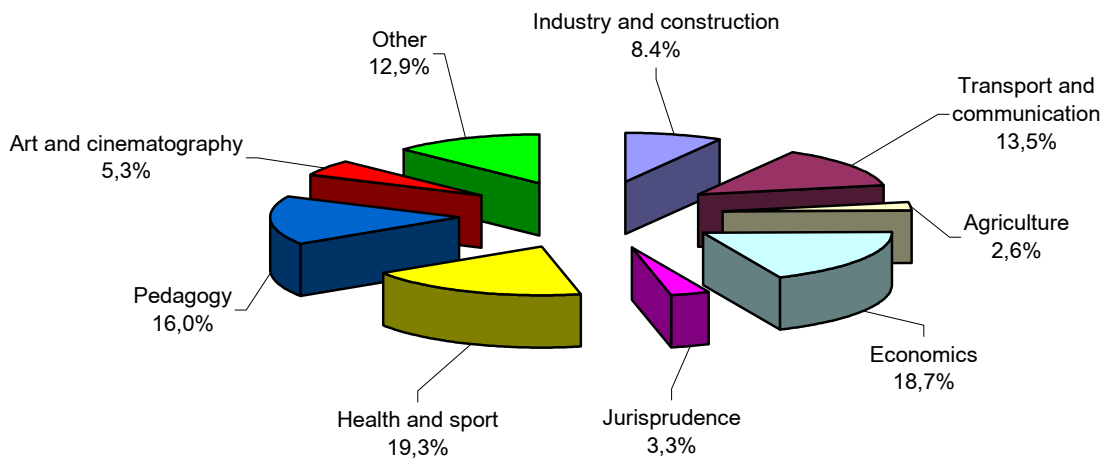

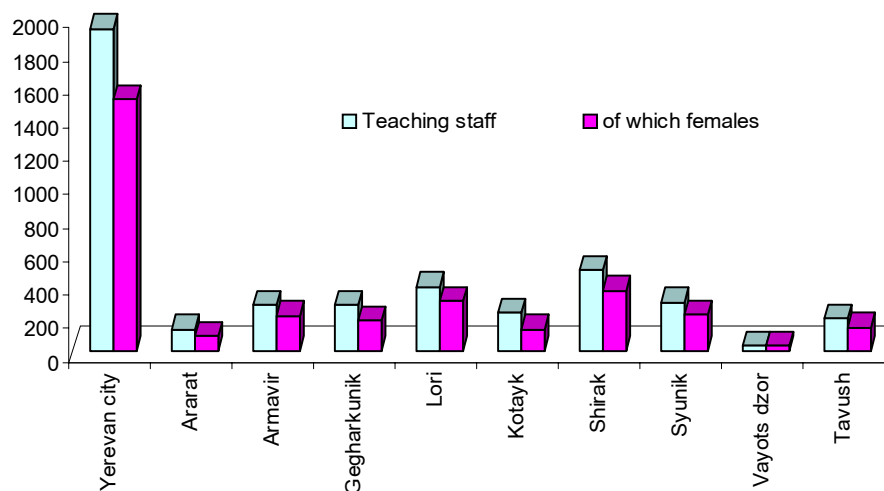

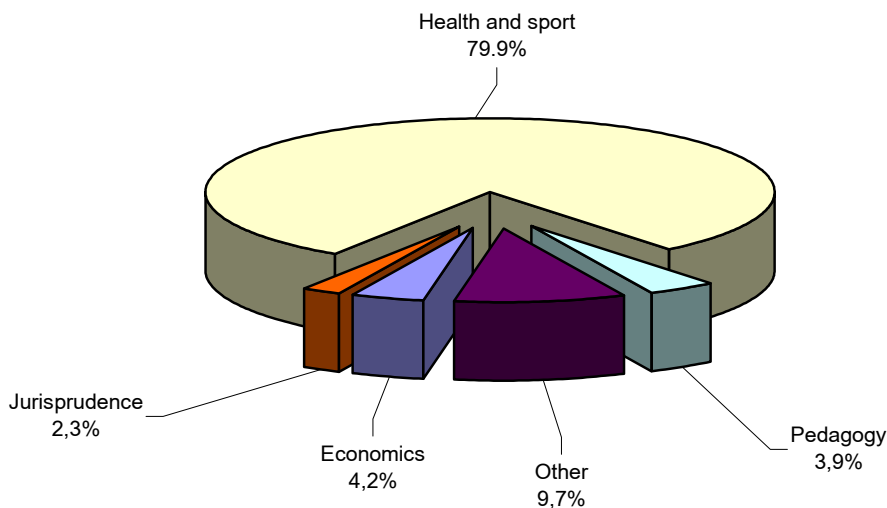
Distribution of Enrolment in Specialized Secondary Non-State Education Establishments

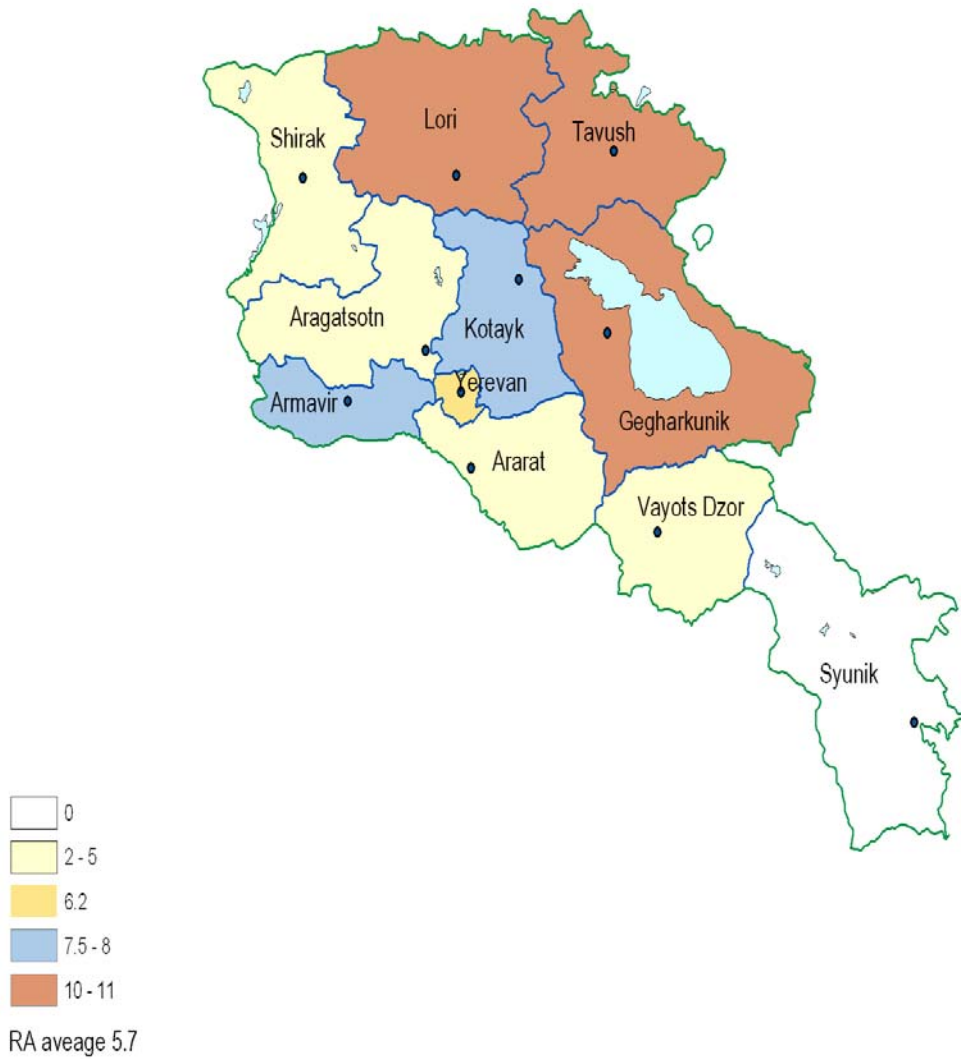

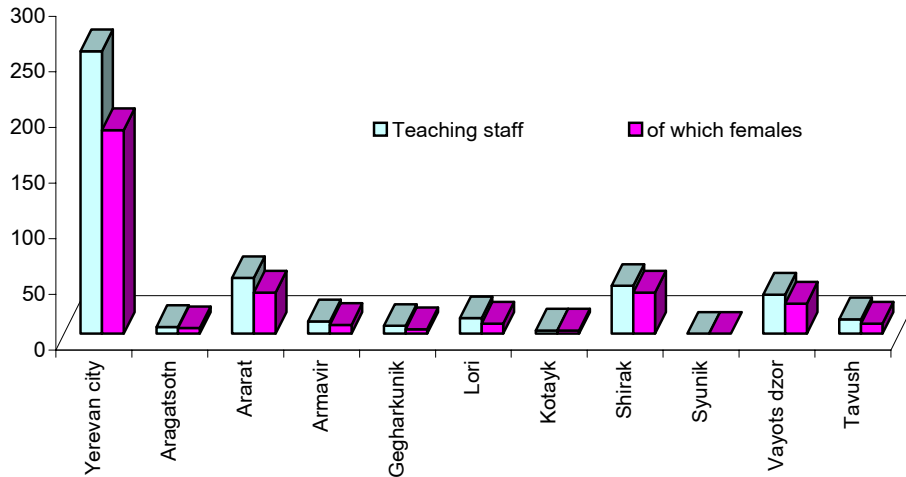
