

5. SOCIO-DEMOGRAPHIC INDICATORS

5.1. Minimal Set of IMF's Social National Data Recommended by UN (Adopted at the 30th Session of the UN Statistical Commission on 05.03.99)

For January-December 2003, out of 15 indicators included in the Minimal Set of Social National Data adopted by the UN Statistical Commission and recommended by the International Statistical Programs and Harmonization Working Group, the National Statistical Service of RA provides information on the following 9 indicators:

5. **Maternal mortality** per 100.000 live births for January-December 2003 comprised 19.7 (7 cases) and for January-December 2002 – 9.3 (3 cases).

7. **Average duration of education in school** for 2002/2003 academic year was 10 years.

12. **GDP per capita** for January-December 2003 comprised 504025 Drams and 871 USD.

14. The unemployment (official) rate for December 2003 was 9.8%. Female unemployment rate for December of 2003 comprised 13.5% and male unemployment rate comprised 6.1%.

15. For January-December 2003, 34.6% of RA population was **employed in economy**, including 31.8% of females and 37.7% of males.

¹ Age-specific death rates of the given year serve as a basis for calculation of life expectancy, meanwhile the most one was the death rate under 1 year.
