

### 3.3. NUMBER OF MEMBERS, STRUCTURE AND PUBLICATIONS OF THE NON-PROFIT INSTITUTIONS

Number of the members of the 779 non-profit institutions covered by the survey, in general, (excluding calculations of trade-unions and trade-union organizations) comprised 516.7 thousand people, of which 32.8 % were women. Number of the territorial infrastructures of the surveyed institutions made up 2324, where 41.8 % of the institution's members or 216.0 thousand people were registered. The parties have the most number of territorial divisions, 36 territorial units per parties, on average.

In accordance with the non-profit institutions' groups separated by the survey, number of the members per institution, on average, comprised 6512 for the parties, 387 – for social organizations, 21 – for the union of the legal entities, and 17 persons – for the funds.

In accordance with the survey results, the social organizations, funds and parties among the groups separated by the survey indicated the availability of publications.

Thus, 11 among the surveyed social organizations have official periodicals. Meanwhile, 7 of those 11 publications are issued on the monthly basis. Only one of the surveyed funds indicated availability of the official periodical, and 4 among the parties. At the same time, the social organizations have also 74 other publications, funds - 11 and parties – 1. It's remarkable that the books, booklets (39.1%) and brochures (33.3%) comprised the big share in the publications other than official periodicals.
