

3.4. MAIN FINANCIAL INDICATORS OF THE NON-PROFIT INSTITUTIONS ACTIVITY

In accordance with the results derived by the survey and estimated with respect to the general universe, the total capital receipts of the non-profit institutions of the republic made up 15357.2 mln. drams during 2001, meanwhile their factual capital payments comprised 14639.1 mln. drams, and the recorded payments - 15069.8 mln. drams.

The biggest share in the total receipts of the non-profit institutions among the groups separated by the survey belonged to the social organizations - 7485.6 mln. drams (or 48.7 % of the total receipts) and funds - 6793.9 mln. drams (or 44.2 %). The capital receipts of the 19 unions of trade-union organizations covered by the survey and trade-union organizations included in them comprised 306.5 mln. drams, which made up 2.0% of the total receipts of the all non-profit institutions.

The total picture was not changed in the capital payments of the non-profit institutions. Thus, the factual capital payments of the social organizations comprised 7086.1 mln. drams (48.4 % of the total factual payments), while the recorded payments - 7145.1 mln. drams or 47.4%.

In accordance with the results estimated with respect to the general universe, the distribution of the capital receipts and payments of the non-profit institutions for 2001 by the shares of the groups separated by the survey is reflected in the Diagram 5.



To include the financial results of the surveyed non-profit institutions in the System of National Accounts, it's necessary to distinguish them by the institutional sectors. Thus, 186 (or 86.1%) out of 216 active non-profit institutions cleared up by the survey render services to the natural persons, while 30 - (or 13.9%) – some group of the legal entities.

From the viewpoint of distinguishing the institutional sectors in the National Accounts, the 71.8% of the active institutions belong to the non-profit institutions serving households.

In accordance with the results estimated with respect to the general universe of the survey, the capital receipts of the institutions of the non-profit institutions serving households sector of the national accounts made up 10200.9 mln. drams (or 66.4% of the total capital receipts), the factual capital payments - 10097.5 mln. drams (69.0% of the total factual payments), while the recorded capital payments - 10317.2 mln. drams or 68.5% of the total recorded capital payments.
